



## Move FAQ

**When is the Center moving?** The Center is scheduled to move Wednesday, July 29, through Friday, July 31. The Center will be closed those days but will reopen Monday, August 3.

**Why is the Center moving?** As part of its Vision 2020 program, Texas A&M University committed to attaining a faculty-student ratio equal to the median of the best public universities. The numbers of students and faculty in Mays Business School are growing rapidly, and Mays needs our current space to help accommodate the growth.

**Will the Center remain part of the Mays Business School?** Definitely. Although we will no longer be in the same building, we will continue as one of the major centers within Mays, and they will continue to provide invaluable support, such as payroll processing.

**Where is the Center moving?** We are relocating to the Texas A&M University Research Park, about two miles west of our present location, closer to Easterwood Airport. Our new physical address will be:
